What Is a Tether and Why Is It Important?



What is a tether?

A tether secures the top of a forward-facing car seat to the vehicle's tether anchor.

Why is it important?

A tether prevents serious head and neck injury by securing the top of the car seat and reducing the distance a child's head moves forward in a crash.

How do I use it?

To provide optimum protection, a tether must be tightened and attached correctly; you can find tether anchor locations in your vehicle owner's manual, and tether installation instructions in your car seat manual.

A tether reduces forward movement in a crash. Collision With Tether Collision Without Tether

Possible Tether Anchor Locations

- Ceiling above/behind rear seating positions
- 2. Rear window shelf
- 3. Back wall (pickup trucks)
- 4. Floor of cargo area
- 5. Under the vehicle seat
- 6. Back of vehicle seat
