Campaign Overview

Campaign Summary

Every year, Americans travel to gather with their friends and loved ones to celebrate their gratitude. Data continues to reflect that many people killed in crashes over the Thanksgiving holiday weekend are unrestrained. Although many drivers are celebrating their thankfulness for their friends and family, they may be causing unintentional harm to their loved ones by making the risky choice to not wear a seat belt. The goal of the 2025 Thanksgiving Seat Belts campaign is to encourage drivers to buckle up every time they hit the road this Thanksgiving.

Objectives

- Emphasize the social and legal consequences of not wearing a seat belt
- Promote positive community values that affirm seat belt safety



Posting Strategy

The 2025 Thanksgiving Seat Belts campaign period runs from November 22 to November 30, 2025. Posting organically on social media during the campaign period will help support the campaign message around seat belt safety and various state law enforcement activities. In addition to posting throughout the campaign, it is recommended to post especially in the days leading up to and on the weekends, as well as on key holidays, to emphasize the importance of the message when people are likely to be celebrating and partaking.

Thanksgiving falls on a Thursday, which makes posting throughout the week leading up to the holiday itself incredibly important to keep the messaging of buckling up at the top of drivers' minds no matter when they decide to celebrate. Increasing posting on Thanksgiving, November 27, will also emphasize the message to drivers who choose to celebrate the day of.

Although social norming and enforcement content are included in the playbook, enforcement should only be used in states where there will be active law enforcement activity throughout the holiday.

Creating Your Own Content

While standard social messages are offered within this playbook, we encourage you to create your own messages to accompany the graphics provided. Over the course of several campaigns, we've seen that messages that localize the campaign and speak to each organization's audience receive significantly more engagement.

There are countless ways to create your own messages or tailor our pre-written messages to your audience, but here are some suggestions to get you started:

- Include the state or city name within the message
- Utilize local crash or traffic stop data
- Mention local celebrations or events to draw a connection to the campaign

Here are some examples of a "create your own" style message:

- Whether you're driving to a family gathering or grabbing a last-minute treat, make sure to buckle up this Thanksgiving, Milwaukee.

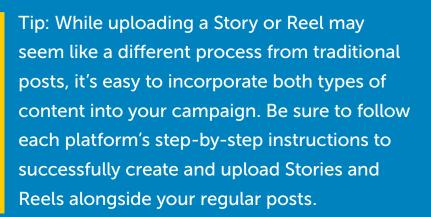
Tip: Animated graphics are uploaded to social platforms in the same way as static versions. Follow the step-by-step instructions provided by the platform during the upload process to easily incorporate animated graphics to your content after downloading them from the website.



Stories and Reels

In addition to the power of feed posts, it's crucial to highlight the growing relevance of Stories and Reels on platforms like Instagram and Facebook, which have become some of the most engaging content formats today. Stories, which disappear after 24 hours, offer a sense of immediacy and urgency, encouraging quick interactions. Reels, on the other hand, have a wider reach due to Meta's algorithm, which prioritizes short, engaging videos. These formats are especially effective for targeting younger audiences who consume content more quickly and are more likely to engage with dynamic, bite-sized videos.
